We believe that you cannot separate life and doctrine. What you believe affects how you live. So we take both doctrine and life seriously. We strive to understand the Bible and apply it in practical ways to our daily life.

We read in Hebrews 12:14 "Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord." Anyone who does not display personal holiness will not be saved. Though our own practical holiness does not save us, it is proof that we possess genuine saving faith. "Faith without works is dead" (James 2:26).

OUR VIEW OF THE LOCAL CHURCH

We believe that Christians need each other and are responsible to join a local church so that they can be instructed, counseled, and, if need be, corrected. The church is a family, which cares about the spiritual welfare of its members.

The worship, policies and practices of the church should be ordered by the Word of God. As such, the will of God, revealed in the Bible, must regulate Church life, rather than pragmatism or tradition. We believe that the preaching and teaching of the Bible should be central in the life of the local church. 
